The most common symptoms of inflammatory bowel disease (IBD) are diarrhea, abdominal and rectal pain and cramping, nausea, vomiting, fatigue, and arthritis-like joint pains. Although its cause is not fully known, IBD involves the immune system and causes inflammation and ulceration of the lining of the intestines. The emotional and physical issues of IBD are interrelated in complex ways and patients can experience flare-ups during times of emotional tension and stress. Changes in cognitive function can also be disease-related and include compromised attention and concentration, reduced capacity to process information, memory disruptions and reduced ability to multitask. Changes in bowel function (diarrhea and bloody stools) can be exacerbated during periods of environmental or physical stress. The college setting can produce all of these types of circumstances.
For these reasons, it is my recommendation that be granted a single occupancy dorm room due to the privacy and bathroom issues and concerns associated with IBD. IBD symptoms need to be managed privately and will need unlimited access to a bathroom.
