INFANT FORMULA SUBSTITUTION GUIDE

The table below provides categories of formulas for premature and term infants. Formulas within each category are comparable and safe to substitute for each other, in case of shortages. Any substitution should only be done under the recommendation and supervision of a healthcare professional.

Please be aware that formula mixing instructions, including proper ratios of powder to water, can vary significantly. Follow all mixing instructions on the container.

Use the specific scoop that comes with each can.
